

## FINANCIAL AID APPEAL

Upon review of your transcripts, you do not meet the minimum satisfactory academic progress requirements, have exceeded the maximum time frame (90 attempted units) or have received an AA/AS degree. Therefore, you are currently **ineligible** to receive financial aid funding. You may submit an appeal for financial aid consideration.

The academic progress requirement does not affect eligibility for the Board of Governor's Fee Waiver (BOGW). However, to regain satisfactory progress you will need to raise your cumulative grade point average to a minimum 2.0 and complete 67% of **all** attempted units.

## BEFORE YOU TURN IN YOUR APPEAL, MAKE SURE YOU REVIEW & FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

1) THIS FORM MUST BE SUBMITTTED TO THE STUDENT FINANCIAL SERVICES OFFICE ALONG WITH THE SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGESS QUIZ (available at <u>www.mjc.edu/financialaid</u>) Keep a copy of your Appeal and submit page 2 along with any supporting documentation.

2) Attach a typed statement explaining why you have not met Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) or have not met your educational goal(s) within the unit maximum allowed. You should include how your <u>unusual</u> <u>circumstances have been resolved</u>. In your statement, you must also explain the circumstances for any recent semesters in which you did not complete all attempted classes and/or your cumulative G.P.A. was below 2.0

Attach copies of supporting documentation for any special circumstances. Examples of supporting documentation:

- Doctor's statement
- Accident claim
- Police report
- Death certificate
- Legal documents that support your Appeal

**The following are <u>not</u> considered extenuating circumstances beyond a student's control:** Personal problems not requiring professional intervention

- Poor time management
- Unaware of academic progress policies or other college requirements
- Not following placement test and/or Academic Counselor's recommendations
- Transportation problems
- Child care problems

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT FINANCIAL AID PROCESS AND GUIDELINES HAVE CHANGED AND WILL BE EVALUATED AFTER EACH SEMESTER.
